- Do not approach any goat with horns. They sometimes get overly playful.
- For your safety, please do not enter any of the horse corrals.
- Do not enter the cat shelter. We have feral cats that we are working with and they may get out.
- Never ever stand behind a large animal.
- Please respect all our animals. This is their home. Some have been abused and appreciate a gentle approach. Do not chase them.
