



## Winslow Farm Animal Awareness, Inc

### WINSLOW FARM WATER PROJECT

Winslow Farm Animal Sanctuary continually provides high quality care for over 100 abandoned and abused farm animals.

Areas of Winslow Farm's water system are over 10 years old. It is necessary to evaluate the system to determine areas that need updating. Plans are to upgrade water lines, repair leaking water pipes, repair outdoor water spigots, add outdoor water spigots where needed and add a hot water tank at the cat shelter.

We estimate the project to cost \$9,600.00. This includes the cost of labor, equipment and materials.

Running water line needs to be added to the cat shelter: this entails putting pipes underground to the shelter, adding a new sink and installing a hot water tank. The cat shelter is kept warm during the winter months by pellet stoves. The cat shelter also houses other animals that might need to be kept warm during the winter. The addition of hot water would enable volunteers to wash the dishes, provide hot compresses to animals that need care and have hot water in the winter to melt frozen water buckets throughout the farm.

Also needed are drainage tanks for runoff of winter snow and torrential rains in two of the barns. This is to alleviate the danger of horses slipping on ice that freezes due to the accumulation of water that has nowhere to go.
